Welcome the Nantucket Community Sailing, Nantucket Race Week and Opera House Cup Newsletter. Please read on to learn about our upcoming season!

Thank You for a Wonderful 30th Season!

We would like to extend a huge thank you to all of our students, instructors, volunteers, friends, supporters, parents and caregivers for a wonderful 2024 season! We had 602 youth program registrations this summer (408 unique students), with ~33% of those registrations from local Nantucket youth residents. Nantucket youth residents are eligible for scholarships through NCS, and we issued over \$85,000 in funding this summer!

We were able to work with the Nantucket Boys and Girls Club, Nantucket S.T.A.R., the Tallship Lynx, and the Saltmarsh Senior Center to provide free sailing and water sports to members of the community. We also taught 12 Adaptive lessons this summer and hosted a 30th anniversary party at our Jetties Sailing Center where we taught over 45 *free* mini sailing lessons to anyone who signed up!

We sent our All-Island Opti and 420 Race Teams to 8 off-island regattas, and had our Jetties Sailing Center open to members and walk-up customers all season long. We had 234 (!!!) Tiny Salts registrations, close to 175 Women's Clinic registrations and over 400 private lesson bookings. Thank you to everyone who sailed with us this past summer; we can't wait to see you in 2025!

Islander Registration opens **Thursday**, **January 23rd at 12:00 Noon EST** and will close Friday, January 24th at 4:00pm EST. This registration period is open to island youth residents who are enrolled in Nantucket schools. *Read below for information on the scholarship application process.*

Returning Sailor Registration opens Monday, January 27th at 12:00 Noon EST and will close Wednesday, January 29th at midnight EST. This registration period is open to families who sailed with NCS Summer 2024 and Island Youth Residents (above).

General Registration opens Monday, February 3rd at 12:00 Noon EST and will remain open. This registration is open to all sailors.

Women's Clinic (Beginner & Advanced) and Private Lessons (Toddler, Youth & Adult) opens Monday, February 10th at 9:00am EST on the Jetties Sailing Center page.

Tiny Salts and Rentals Registration will open Monday, June 2nd at 9:00AM on the Jetties Sailing Center Page.

We plan on running a full slate of programs in 2025, with some slight

modifications! Our season will run from Monday, June 23 - Friday, August 22 (8 weeks of programming plus a 9th week with private lessons only.) We hope to see you on the water next summer!

Week 1: You pay only \$100! Week 2 - 8: 50% Scholarship



Our NCS Summer Instructors are always up to amazing things! Here's a little update!


